## Instructions for spectators for the raceday in Prague-Velká Chuchle (5 June):

Gates open: from 12:00.

Every person, with the exception of children under the age of 6, must prove one of the following documents:

- valid certified confirmation of the covid-test with a negative result, not older than 72 hours (for children 6-18 years, a negative result of a preventive antigen test not older than 6 days is sufficient)

- valid proof of against covid-vaccination - at least 21 days from the first vaccination

- a valid document of Covid-19 disease, not older than 180 days

## A PERSON WHO DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THE CONDITIONS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED INTO THE AREA!

For people who have not taken the test in the last seven days, there will be a free antigen testing tent in front of the main entrance from 12 to 16 hours (other people: test for pay 350 CZK). The capacity is set to the expected number of people, however, in the case of the planned use of this testing, we recommend counting on time with arrival to take the test and evaluate the test in the order of minutes to low tens of minutes.

► All persons in the race area, with the exception of horse riders, are obliged to use respiratory protection – a respirator or similar device.

Persons in the auditorium of the grandstand are obliged to take their seats so that they have at least one free seat between them (does not apply to members of the common household).

▶ It will be possible to buy refreshments at the racetrack, the sale of which will take place in accordance with current measures of state administration bodies, but there is a ban on the consumption of food and beverages in the auditorium.

► There will be places for betting (paddocks, small and large betting halls) in operation at the racecourse.

Prize-giving ceremonies will take place.
